NAUI / SDI / PADI Private or Semi-Private Open Water SCUBA Diver Course

As a certified Open Water SCUBA Diver you have the freedom to dive with a buddy independent of a professional.

Pre-requisites:

You should be a reasonably proficient swimmer, comfortable and relaxed in the water. A mature attitude, good judgment and self-discipline are all required. Your general health should be good. Ages 10+ (Ages 10 – 14 receive a Jr. Open Water Certification)

What will you do?

Throughout the course, you'll learn fundamentals of scuba diving, including dive equipment and techniques. You earn this rating by completing 5 pool skill modules and knowledge development sessions and by making four open water (ocean or lake) dives. This is a self study course, where the student does all reading and watches the videos at home.

Orientation:

Will take place at Lehigh Valley Dive Center at your convenience. It will take between 1 and 2 hours.

Classroom:

Is self study or for a slight extra charge Online e-Learning

Pool Sessions:

2 – 3 sessions at the Bethlehem Township Community Center, your pool, or another facility. These arrangements will be made between you and your instructor. Each session will last 3 – 4 hours.

Dives:

Can be completed locally at Dutch Springs, or a referral can be issued to complete you checkout dives at another location or on your vacation. The dives at Dutch Springs are done over 2 days, 4-6 hours each day.

Cost: \$450.00 Complete, \$375.00 with a referral to another location for your Open Water checkout dives

Included: Complete student kit with text book, log book and tables, certification card (PIC), all instructor fees, pool equipment.

Student must purchase:

Personal fit equipment: Mask, snorkel, fins and boots (approx. \$99 - 300) 10% Student Discount at Lehigh Valley Dive Center!

2 Days entry into Dutch Springs (2 X \$32 = \$64)

Complete Open Water equipment rental (\$69) which includes full wetsuit, all equipment, tanks and air fills for certification dives. Covers all 4 dives, 2 tanks including air re-fills, regulator with gauges, BC with inflator, full wet suit including hood, gloves and weight belt with weights.

Lehigh Valley Dive Center is located 1 mile north of Rt. 22 on Rt. 191 (Nazareth Pike). www.LVDive.com

Bethlehem Township Community Center is located at 2900 Farmersville Road in Bethlehem. It is 1 mile from the William Penn Highway exit of Rt. 33 and 4 miles from Lehigh Valley Dive Center. www.btcenter.org
